***7:40 pm Call to order**

***Attendance. Introductions. Two teams missing representatives at the meeting.**

***We are currently at 90% compliance as a club for the new concussion regulation.**

***Bob Yoseph needs two names to register the club with the State. Brandon Schreiner will be one. Many suggested Jeff Orwick be the other. A quick vote was taken.**

***U-11 Thursday Trainings are going well. Big turnout. Brandon Schreiner asked if U-10 kids could turn out for the Thursday training. Jason Quintero said no, as he does not want to have it appear that the U-11 training night is for recruitment purposes. Brandon Schreiner indicated that he would be pulling from the U-17, U-16 teams to bring players down to train the U-11 players.**

***Brandon Schreiner has bottled water and River City water bottles available that can be sold as fund raisers. A portion of the proceeds has to be given back to River City SC. Anyone interested should contact Brandon.**

Brandon also has coaches jackets, captains bands, etc available. There is also a supply of tournament t-shirts available for \$5 each.

Legends Photography will give back 20% of what is spent with their company to any River City team that utilizes their services.

***Fields: Central Valley School District does not think they have been paid for field usage last year. Bob Yoseph is looking into the issue by pulling old bank statements and will either provide proof that they were paid or pay the bill in the next week.**

Currently River City SC has 2 fields reserved Mon-Thurs of each week at Plantes Ferry Park. Brandon suggested that everyone show up on a first come first serve basis each night with scrimmages taking priority over regular training. Instead, Jeff Orwick volunteered to coordinate the Plantes

***Brandon Schreiner also sent out another reminder that it is mandatory for ALL teams practicing at Plantes Ferry to practice in a River City shirt. It gives a more polished image to the public in representing our club.**

***Steve Wee gave the name of a website www.prepsportswear.com where teams can have customized team clothing made and 10% of the proceeds come back to the team.**

***Brandon Schreiner and Jason Quintero will be attending a grievance hearing on Wednesday filed by SYSA over a boundary violation for recruitment of teams. All River City teams are asked to make certain we do not go outside our boundaries for practices, fund raisers etc. If you plan to pay for a facility outside our normal boundaries, you must run it by Amber Haase first. Shock facility is currently available on Fridays and Sundays.**

Brandon will also be meeting with the Valley Soccer Association and issuing a complaint about how the association applies rules. Brandon would like the rules enforced and applied equally to all clubs and coaches.

***District level teams are not required to bring a stamped envelope to their games. Brandon will address the fact that the U11 Foxes did not have any officials show up at their first game last weekend.**

***Brandon will be raising club dues by \$16 next year.**

***Brandon is looking at going with club uniforms that have no name brand to save parents money.**

***Seattle Sounders have taken over the ODP program. ODP Players will be contacted this week. All 95,96, and 97 coaches are encouraged to contact Brandon with their potential ODP players immediately, if they have not already done so.**
